



Emanuel "Mooney" Mayer

April 13, 1920 - September 2, 2004

Emanuel "Mooney" Mayer, age 84, of Glendive, went to be home with our Lord on Sunday, August 29, 2004. Funeral services will be at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, September 2, 2004 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastors Paul Everett and Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Mooney was born on April 13, 1920 at Hebron, North Dakota, the son of Carl and Lydia (Frey) Mayer. Mooney was raised and educated in Hebron. He joined the Civilian Conservation Corp (C.C.C.) In 1938 and was discharged in April of 1940. He reenlisted in April of 1941 until October of 1941. From 1942 until 1944, during World War II, he worked at the shipyards in Stockton, California. Mooney then returned to Hebron and began working for Montana Dakota Utilities in June of 1944. He was united in marriage to Edna Stahlecker Irion on December 19, 1953 in Hebron. They moved to Glendive in May of 1954. He retired from M.D.U. in April of 1982 after 38 years of service. Following his retirement, Mooney drove the activities bus for Dawson County High School, Dawson Community College and the Glendive Legion Baseball Team. Mooney and his wife spent the winter months in Arizona. Mooney was a member of the Glendive Moose Lodge #949 and Glendive Elks Lodge #1324. He was also a member of the Zion Lutheran Church, Breakfast Lions and Noon Lions Clubs. He also served in various capacities helping with the Oktoberfest in Glendive. Mooney enjoyed fishing, hunting and spending time at their cabin at Tobacco Gardens.

He loved his children and grandchildren very much and was very proud of their achievements. He will be dearly missed but not forgotten. Mooney was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Harold and Elmore. He is survived by his wife, Edna, of Glendive; his son, Kevin Mayer and his wife Lori of Sidney, Montana; his daughters, Deanna Chrest and her husband Vernon of Minot, North Dakota and Cheryl Brown and her husband Craig of Glenmont, New York; one brother, Ellsworth Mayer and his wife Carolyn of Pendleton, Oregon; seven sisters, Violet Jose and her husband Eddie, Inez Link and her husband Bill and Bernice Huber and her husband Willie, all of Bismarck, North Dakota, Dorothy Borchert and her husband Irving of Umatilla, Oregon, Arlene Hughes and Gertrude Armstrong and her husband Bob, all of Lincoln, Montana, Barbara Behrens and her husband Bill of Austin, Texas; 11 grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.
