



Emma R. Grebeldinger

February 14, 1930 - October 4, 2006

Emma R. Grebeldinger, age 76, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, October 4, 2006 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. A private family committal service will be held at the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive at a later date. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Emma was born on February 14, 1930, in Marsh, Montana, the daughter of Jacob and Maria (Ruff) Gaub. Emma resided in Marsh with her family and received her early education there. Her father died when she was five years old, and the family continued to reside on the farm for another two years before moving to Glendive. She then received her education in Glendive schools and attended Dawson County High School in Glendive. Following her education, Emma resided in San Bernardino, California for a short time. She then returned to Montana and was united in marriage to Roy W. Grebeldinger on May 26, 1951 in Miles City, Montana. Emma and Roy made their home in Glendive where Emma worked at the Glendive Bakery until April of 1952 when she became a full time wife, mother and homemaker. Emma enjoyed gardening, reading and embroidery. She was a member of the First Congregational United Church of Christ and was active with fund raising activities and a member of their Pilgrim Circle. Emma was preceded in death by her parents; two sisters, Magdalena Gaub and Bertha Taron; and four brothers, Fred Gaub, John Gaub, Bernie Gaub and Art Gaub. Survivors include her husband, Roy Grebeldinger of Glendive; two daughters, Kathy Broeder and her husband Warren of Glendive and Sue
