Erma Eunice Guenther, age 90, of Wibaux, Montana, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, passed away Thursday, November 4, 2010 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. Visitation will be held Monday, November 8, 2010 from 1:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Chapel in Beach and one hour prior to the funeral service at the United Community Church in Beach. She grew up on the family farm northeast of Beach, North Dakota. She went to grade school at the Bunker Hill School that was located about a mile from their farm home. She graduated from Beach High School with the class of 1942. After high school, Erma worked for Dr. C.A. Bush as a nurses aide at the old Beach Hospital. She later moved to Glendive, Montana and worked at the N.P. Hospital. Erma married Donald Guenther on February 27, 1948. Three children were born to this union, Diane, Charles, and Donna. Don and Erma farmed for many years north of Beach. In 1962, the family moved into Beach and Erma went back to work as a nurses aide. In 1970, Don, Erma, and Donna made their home in Missoula, Montana where Erma continued her career as a nurses aide. She moved back to Beach in 1982 moving into the Golden Valley Manor and also

working there as the night security person. Erma was active in the Bonnie View Homemakers Club for many years. She attended the Evangelical Church of North America and was active in the women's fellowship group and bible study. She later joined the United Community Church and continued her interest in church activities even after her move to the Wibaux County Nursing Home. She was preceded in death by her parents, one infant sister, and her two brothers. She is survived by her sister Vivian Hackett, of Hayden, Idaho; daughter, Diane (Michael) Bingeman, of Beach; son, Charles (Mary Lynn) Guenther, of Yakima, Washington, and daughter Donna (Dan Johnson) Guenther of Billings, Montana; sister-in-law, Vera Slocomb Schneider; 7 grandchildren; 10 great grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
