April 15, 1932 - May 23, 2014

Ervin Lovaas, age 82, of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Monday, May 19, 2014 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in Glendive. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Friday, May 23, 2014 at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will be held in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Ervin was born on April 15, 1932, in Glendive, the son of Erling and Cora (Fowler) Lovaas. He was raised and educated in Glendive attending high school at Dawson County High School graduating with the class of 1950. Ervin took a lot of pride in his garden and yard. He enjoyed playing poker at the Oasis, taking care of the neighbors dogs and visiting with all his surrounding neighbors in Winchester Place.
