Ethel A. (Hickman) Gambriel, age 95, of Glendive and formerly of Terry, Montana, passed away on Tuesday, November 11, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive. She and her husband lived in Terry where her husband was employed by the railroad and they raised their family in Terry, during which time Ethel also worked at the jewelry store there. She was preceded in death by her husband on March 19, 1973. Ethel remained in Terry for several more years until moving to Soap Lake, Washington to be near her family. She married Chuck Gambriel on February 14, 1980 in Soap Lake. He preceded her in death in February of 1981. Ethel continued to lived in Soap Lake until 1984 when she

returned to Montana to Plentywood where she lived until 1987 when she moved back to Terry. Ethel resided in Terry until moving to Beach, North Dakota in 1996 to be near her granddaughter and her husband. In 1999, Ethel moved to Glendive where she resided until the time of her death. Ethel enjoyed watching baseball and crocheting. Ethel was preceded in death by her parents; an infant daughter; one son, Gayle in 2001 and four brothers.
