She went on to achieve her Masters Degree in Guidance and Counseling from Eastern Montana College in Billings, Montana. Ettabelle taught school at Washington Middle School in Glendive from 1974 to 1980 and in May of 1980, Ettabelle and Clyde moved to Dickinson where she also taught school. The couple moved to Gillette, Wyoming where she continued teaching until 1984. In 1984, she and her husband moved to Satanta, Kansas

where Ettabelle taught until 2001 when she retired and returned to Glendive. Following her return to Glendive, Ettabelle came out of retirement to teach at the Deer Creek School near Glendive, a position that she held until the completion of the 2012 school year. Ettabelle loved reading and watching her granddaughter in all of her athletic endeavors. She also enjoyed golfing. Ettabelle was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Carl Williams Jr. Survivors include her husband, Clyde of Glendive; one son, Scott Herring and his wife Melissa of Glendive; one granddaughter, Brooke K.
