Eugene "Gene" McDanold, age 78, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, August 25, 2003 at his home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, August 28, 2003 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Eugene was born on October 18, 1924 in Fargo, North Dakota, the son of John Andrew and Ruby May (Stedwell) McDanold. He moved with his family to Beach, North Dakota where he was raised and attended rural Beach area schools. Eugene entered the U.S. Navy on March 6, 1946 and served during World War II and also in Korea. He was honorably discharged in September of 1953. He was united in marriage to Lucille Irene Schultz on May 5, 1948 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. They resided in Beach, North Dakota until 1949 when they moved to Glendive. Eugene was employed by N.P. Transport as a truck driver until becoming the Store Manager for the State Liquor Store in Glendive. He was a member of the American Legion and the Glendive Moose Lodge #949. Eugene was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and had served as local and district commander. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, woodworking and spending time in his garage. Eugene was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Lester and Merlin and one sister, Evelyn Schieffer.
