



Eugenia Rojic

September 14, 1931 - July 3, 2015

Eugenia "Sis" Eileen (Kunick) Rojic, age 83, of Beach, North Dakota and Wibaux, Montana passed away on Friday, July 3, 2015 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, Montana. Visitation will be held from 3:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. and from 6:00 P.M. until 7:00 P.M. on Monday, July 6, 2015 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. A Vigil Service will be at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, July 6, 2015 at St. Peter's Catholic Church. A Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:30 A.M. on Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at St. Peter's Catholic Church with Father Xavier Arimboor officiating. Rite of Committal will follow in the Wibaux Cemetery. Sis was born on September 14, 1931 on the Kunick family homestead in Sentinel Butte, North Dakota, a daughter of Emil and Janie (Rathbun) Kunick. She was raised and educated in Sentinel Butte attending elementary school at the Plainview Country School and later graduating from Sentinel Butte High School with the class of 1951. Following her high school education she went on to attend a year of college in Dickinson, North Dakota before moving back home to Sentinel Butte. While back in her home town Sis met and later married Al Rojic on June 16, 1954 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Sentinel Butte. Shortly after their marriage they moved to Wibaux until they purchased a ranch southwest of town in 1963. Together, Sis and Al lived on the ranch and raised their three daughters.

Sis was a very gifted gardener, and grew beautiful flowers outside and in her

own greenhouse, "Sis's Plant Shop." She also had a talent for quilting, crocheting and embroidery as well. She crafted gorgeous quilts and gave one to each of her ten grandchildren. Sis also enjoyed cooking, canning, and making jams and jellies.

In March of 2012 Sis moved to Beach and resided at the Golden Valley Manor. She loved her time at the Manor and made numerous friends there, especially Donna Sygulla and Dorothy Stolberg.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Emil and Janie; one brother, Bud Kunick; one sister, Darlene Myers; an infant brother, Emil Duane; and two brothers-in-law, Warren Myers and Jack Rojic.
