September 1, 1911 - January 2, 2004

Eva Marie Trester, age 92, formerly of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota, passed away at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana, on Wednesday, December 24, 2003. Funeral Services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, January 2, 2004 at the Evangelical Church in Beach, North Dakota with Reverend Scott Jordan officiating. A private interment will be held at the Sentinel Butte Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Marie was born September 1, 1911 in Kascoiski Co., Indiana, a daughter of William Henry and Maude Marie (Wagner) Hollar. She moved with her parents to Beach in 1918. Marie's mother passed away when she was nine years old. Her dad later remarried Clara Anderson. Marie attended school through the sixth grade. Marie married Henry Arnold Trester on September 4, 1926. Because Marie's stepmother was ill, Marie and Henry took Marie's half sister, Betty Lou on their honeymoon as far as Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, where they left her in the care of her Aunt Gena till her mother recovered. Marie and Henry continued on to Indiana where they spent the next month of their honeymoon. Henry and Marie farmed in the rural Sentinel Butte area until 1949 when they added a farm in Princeton, Minnesota, to their holdings. This was Marie's first house with running water and indoor plumbing. In 1962, Marie's daughter Joyce and her husband, Ken, took over the farm in Minnesota and Marie moved back to Sentinel Butte. Marie loved flowers, gardening, and handy work. She also liked watching and caring for birds. She had feeders, birdhouses, and waterers all over her yard in Sentinel Butte.

Marie was preceded in death by her dad, mother, stepmother, brothers Harold, Francis and baby D. Eldon, sister Helen, age 6, and her husband Henry. Marie is survived by a son, Larry Trester of St. Louis Park, Minnesota; a daughter, Joyce Selin of Princeton, Minnesota, and her son, Boyd Trester of Sentinel Butte; half sister, Betty Lou Lohmann Horn of Big Horn, Montana; sister-in-law, Marie Hollar of Medora; nine grandchildren, 33 great grandchildren, and five great great grandchildren.
