



## Eva Welsh

August 17, 1915 - October 23, 2005

Eva Scabad Welsh, age 90, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, October 23, 2005 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive following a lengthy illness. Private family graveside services were held on Tuesday, October 25, 2005 in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Eva was born at Glendive on August 17, 1915, the oldest child of Nick and Elizabeth (Roeszer) Scabad. She received her education in the Glendive schools, graduating from Dawson County High School in 1934. In 1936, she graduated from Eastern Montana State Normal, Billings, where she met the love of her life, Donald H. Welsh. They married on June 1, 1938. She received a B.A. in English from Billings Polytechnic Institute in 1941 and took graduate work in English at the University of Montana. She taught lower grades at Carlyle and English at Lavina and Frazer, all in Montana, and at the University of Missouri (Columbia) campus school. Eva was highly skilled at handicrafts, a perfectionist, and won many awards, including the silver cup at the North Dakota Winter Show, Valley City. She was a loving wife, mother and grandmother and took special pride in the accomplishments of her son, Hugh and grandson, Sean, both of Rapid City, South Dakota. Both "Eve" and Don both especially enjoyed their years in Custer (1951 - 1955) and in Valley City (1961 - 1997), two very different communities but both a delight in which to live and work. Eva was preceded in death by her parents, brother, Wendell and sisters, Elizabeth and Pearl. She is survived by her husband of 67 years,

Dr. Don Welsh of Glendive; her son Hugh (Heidi) and grandson Sean; her brother, Raymond J. Scabad of Daly City, California and her brother-in-law, Russell Welsh of Wibaux, Montana.
