



## Evelyn Marguerite Kondelik

June 25, 1937 - February 20, 2025

Evelyn Marguerite Kondelik, 87, passed away on February 20, 2025, at Suncoast Hospice Care Center Mid Pinellas in Pinellas Park, Florida. Evelyn was born on June 25, 1937, in Helena, Montana and spent most of her life in the Glendive and Circle communities. She grew up in Lindsay and Glendive, graduating from Dawson County High School in 1955. She joined the Women's Army Corp (WAC) after high school and spent her 3 years of service in Orleans, France and Chicago, Illinois and was discharged in 1958 as Specialist 3rd Class. She was also a member of the Airforce National Guard and was discharged as Airman 2nd Class in 1961. Most of her professional life she worked in several administrative roles. In Glendive, after the Army, she worked for attorney Russell McDonough and bartended at the Jordan Hotel.

Evelyn moved to Circle in 1961 after her marriage to Emil J Kondelik where she lived for 40+ years raising her family while living on the family farm south of Circle. During this time, she worked performing office/administrative duties at St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church, McCone County Hospital & Nursing Home, and the McCone Conservation District. She was the secretary for many boards including the Fort Peck Interpretive Center, where she later became an employee. She then moved to Glasgow to be closer to her work after her husband Emil and mother Paulina passed away. Evelyn eventually moved to the Dallas, Texas area to be closer to her son Jeff, then to New Braunfels, Texas to be closer to her daughter Maureen. In October 2020 she

moved in with her daughter Jeanne at Jeanne's home in St. Peterburg, Florida.

Evelyn's hobbies included embroidery, sewing, reading, and watching cooking shows. She was also involved in the Summit Homemakers Club and Washington Warriors 4-H club. She spent many hours driving and attending her children's sporting events.

Evelyn was preceded in death by her husband Emil J. Kondelik, father Basil Gavin, mother Paulina Johnson, step father Dale Johnson and sister Loretta Livingston.

Evelyn is survived by her children: Doug (Monique) of Great Falls, Montana, Joe (Kim) of Townsend, Montana, Andrew of Gallatin, Tennessee; Maureen of Richlands, North Carolina; Jeanne of St. Petersburg, Florida; and Jeff (Jana) of Aubrey, Texas. Brother In-Law Lloyd Livingston, and nephews Bill and Brad. Granddaughters: Heather, Emily (Sean) and Mary. Grandsons: Daniel, Kenneth, James (Katie) and Jonathon (Liz). Great Grandchildren: Emilia, Adriana, Landon, Evie, Logan and Stevie. Step Grandchildren: Rob (Kacy), Jory, Jennifer, Justin, Matthew, McKenzie, Syvanah, and Daniel. Along with many other nieces, nephews and Great Grandchildren.
