

Evelyn Marie Siegle

April 4, 1934 - September 6, 2023

Evelyn Marie Siegle, age 89 of Wibaux, Montana passed away on Wednesday, September 6, 2023 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. A memorial service will be held at 1:00 PM on Friday, September 15, 2023 at the Wibaux County Fairgrounds in Wibaux with Liz Franz officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive, Montana. Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux has been entrusted with the arrangements. Evelyn Marie Catherine Beck Siegle was born to Henry and Ella (Lenz) Beck on April 4, 1934 in Leigh, Nebraska. Her grade school education was at Zion Lutheran School in Leigh and she graduated from Leigh High School with the class of 1952. Evelyn then attended Concordia Teacher's College in Seward, Nebraska for two years and a summer. Then she taught two years at St. Paul's Lutheran in Sidney, Nebraska and two years at St. John's Lutheran at Columbus, Nebraska while attending summer school at Concordia Teacher's College. She then returned for a full year and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Education in 1959 and was placed by the college at Trinity Lutheran School in Billings, Montana where she would teach and meet Phillip Siegle. After teaching in Billings for two years, she and Phillip were married at Zion Lutheran Church in Leigh on August 13, 1961 in the same church that she was baptized and confirmed in. They lived on a farm west of Glendive from 1961-1967 when they moved to Nebraska to be closer to her mother who was dying of cancer. In 1968, they moved back to Montana to the Roy Amunrud place north of Wibaux. In 1969,

Evelyn started working at the school as an aide and in the fall of 1970, she started teaching kindergarten there. She taught there until 1997, twenty years in kindergarten, three years in fourth grade and four years in the third grade while also teaching music for grades K-2 until retiring in May of 1997. After retirement, Evelyn started as a full-time volunteer, active in the Senior Citizens, Nursing Home Auxiliary and Trinity Lutheran Church Ladies Aide, serving as president for many years in all three organizations. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Wibaux since 1968, sang in the choir, played piano at the nursing home, made many quilt tops for quilts for Lutheran World Relief and sewed more than 250 pillowcase dresses for little girls in Africa.

Preceding Evelyn in death were her parents, her husband Phillip in 2020; daughter, Donna Kearnes in 1994; her brothers, Arlen and Ronald Beck; two nieces, Rita Macari and Karen Beck.

She is survived by her children, John (Teresa) Siegle of Wibaux and Lisa Wentz of Wibaux and Pierz, Minnesota; eight grandchildren; six great grandchildren; two sisters-in-law, Marian Beck of Leigh and Sharolyn Beck of Omaha, Nebraska and numerous nieces and nephews.

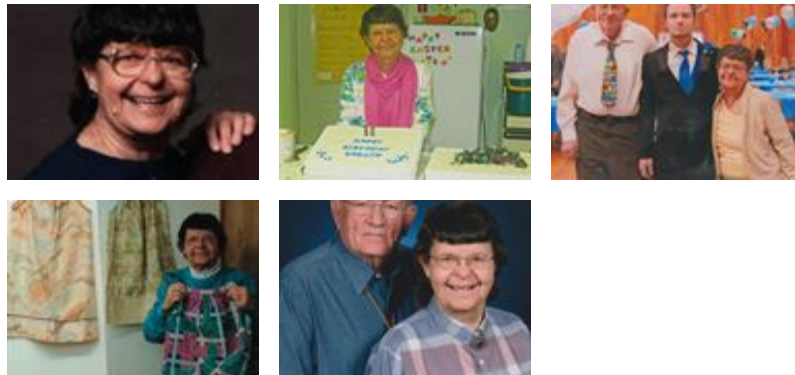
