



## Evelyn Toepke

January 9, 1920 - February 1, 2006

Evelyn Toepke, age 86, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, January 25, 2006 in the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. Memorial services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Wednesday, February 1, 2006 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will be held at 11:00 A.M. (CST), Thursday, February 2, 2006 in the Judson Cemetery in Judson, North Dakota with Pastor Joshua Eddy officiating. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Evelyn was born on January 9, 1920 in New Salem, ND to August and Maggie (Weiss) Vollrath. She attended school in New Salem and graduated from New Salem High School with the class of 1938. On September 24, 1939 she married Theodore (Ted) Toepke in New Salem, North Dakota. They lived in Judson, ND until the Northern Pacific Railroad transferred them to Miles City and Terry, MT and finally to Glendive in 1954. The Toepke's built their own home in Hillcrest and were the first family to reside in the new subdivision. After her husband's death in 1960, Evelyn worked three years for Farnum & Gabert Drug and nineteen years for Montana-Dakota Utilities. Evelyn moved to Havre, MT after retiring from MDU in 1982. She lived there until 1992 when she moved back to New Salem, ND. She returned to Glendive in October of 2001 and moved into the Grandview Retirement Home where she renewed old acquaintances and made many new friends. In May of 2005 Evelyn moved to The Heritage. Evelyn volunteered at Highland Park School in Havre, MT for many years. She enjoyed working in her beautiful flower garden in Hillcrest,

reading and traveling. She made fantastic raised doughnuts that her children and grandchildren still remember. She was a member of Zion Lutheran Church. Evelyn was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, her brother, Arnold Vollrath, and her sister, Eleanor Hurmance. Evelyn is survived by her son, Wes (Debra) Toepke of Glendive, MT, her daughters, Correen (Ross) Major of Sioux Falls, SD and Cathie (Doug) Mann of Payson, AZ, 11 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.
