Floyd Artie Scott, age 78, of Glendive, Montana, passed away November 4, 2016 at the Eastern Montana Veteran's Home in Glendive. A graveside service with Military Honors will be held a later date at the Glacier Memorial Gardens in Kalispell, Montana. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Floyd was born February 8, 1938 in Sidney, Montana to Artie S. and Mildred (Campbell) Scott, the oldest of 6 children. He attended school in Glendive and received his GED. At the age of 18, he joined the Navy. He was stationed in San Francisco, California. After his honorable discharge, Floyd came home and worked at various places in Glendive. Floyd married Louise Smith in 1960, and to this union four children were born- Sherry Scott of Rapid City, South Dakota, Leo Scott of Deer Lodge, Montana, Deborah (Shannon) Sell of Glendive, and Tony Scott of Williston, North Dakota. Floyd took his family to Kalispell where he spent all but the last five years of his life- this was his home. Floyd later married Gloria Gilbert for a short time before their divorce. While in Kalispell, Floyd worked at C&C Plywood and Snowline Tree Co. and helped take care of his parents until going to Deer Lodge. Floyd came back to Kalispell for a short time before moving to Fallon, Montana and Terry, Montana. Floyd moved to the EMVH in January of 2016 and lived there until his death.

Floyd was preceded in death by his parents.

Floyd is survived by all four of his children and their families; five siblings,

Sam Scott of Kalispell, Florence Wambeke of Rapid City, Philip (Joyce) Scott of Somers, Montana, Ida (Ken) Lacquement of Terry, and Alice Dschaak of Rapid City; and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
