



## Frances Demaray

March 11, 1904 - April 14, 2004

Frances (Kelly) Demaray (Sis), age 100, of Glendive, died on Monday, April 12, 2004 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Wednesday, April 14, 2004 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Reverend Denis Fournier officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Frances was born on March 11, 1904, in Glendive, Montana, to Irish parents, Margaret (Peoples) Kelly and John A. Kelly. She married Mert Demaray in 1935 and they were later divorced. She was the only girl in her family of five protective brothers. After graduating from Dawson County High School she worked for the County Agent in Glendive for ten years. She joined the U.S. Air Force in October 1943 and served for two years in England, France and the United States. After her discharge from the service, she was employed by the Alaskan Railroad as a stenographer for 20 years. In 1966, she retired and spent the next ten years just enjoying Seattle. In 1976 she moved back to Montana to be closer to her siblings and their families, settling in Billings. She lived independently and maintained her own home in Billings until the age of 92 when she moved into an assisted living apartment at St. Johns Lutheran Home. She went full circle when she moved back to her birthplace, Glendive, and entered the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in November 1999. Frances was preceded in death by her parents; her brothers, Francis (Peggy), William (Bill), Robert (Rob), John (Jake) and James
