Frances received her education at Lonesome School District in Flasher until the tenth grade and finished high school at St. Mary's High School in Bismarck, North Dakota, graduating with the class of 1944. After high school she attended St. Alexius Hospital School of Nursing in Bismarck from 1944 until 1947 and received a diploma degree. Frances met and later married Leslie A. Jorgenson on June 21, 1947 in Flasher, and to this union four children were born; Leslie, John, Frances and Donald. Frances and Leslie made their home in Bismarck until Leslie passed away in 1957. Frances worked at St. Alexius Hospital as the first Lead Nurse in ICU until 1969 when she moved to Sentinel Butte and married Herman F. Dietz on October 11,

1969. Herman brought to this union his children; Conrad, Gordon, Paul, Sister Mariah, Joy, Daniel, Mary and Jill who they raised together. Frances worked at the Golden Valley County Hospital in Beach from 1970 until it closed in 1985. She then became employed at Home on the Range until her retirement in 2004. Frances was preceded in death by her parents, C.P. and Martha Breiner; her husbands, Leslie A. Jorgenson and Herman F.
