August 30, 1925 - January 2, 2006

Frederick Thomas Kremers, age 80, of Beach, North Dakota, formerly of Golva, North Dakota, died at Med Center One in Bismarck, North Dakota on Thursday, December 29, 2005. A Mass Of Christian Burial will be recited at 3:00 P.M. Monday, January 2, 2006 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva with Rev. Fr. David Richter officiating. A Rosary will be recited at 2:15 P.M. Monday prior to the Mass Of Christian Burial. Rite of Committal will be at 1:00 P.M. Central Time on Tuesday, January 3, 2005 at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery at Mandan, North Dakota. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Fred was born August 30, 1925 at the family farm south of Golva, North Dakota, the son of Leo A. and Josephine (Rising) Kremers. He received his early education at the Hillside country school south of Golva and graduated from the Golva High School with the class of 1944. On March 28, 1944 Fred joined the United States Marines. He participated in action against the enemy at Okinawa, Ryukyu Islands and in the occupation of Japan. Fred was discharged on July 18, 1946. Fred then returned to the Golva, North Dakota area where he was engaged in farming. Fred was married to Dolores Orstad at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva on August 22, 1949. Fred was a lifetime member of the VFW and the American Legion. He enjoyed a good joke and teasing his nieces, nephews and grandchildren. Fred was preceded in death by his parents and an infant brother. Fred is survived by his wife Dolores of Beach, North Dakota; one son Steve Kremers and his wife Marie of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota; one daughter Vickie Hardy

of Fargo, North Dakota; two sisters, Mary Bibb of Spokane, Washington and Leona Krueger and her husband Walt of Longmont, Colorado; two brothers, Bob Kremers and his wife Maylou of Lincoln, Nebraska and James Kremers and his wife Elaine of Golva, North Dakota; six grandchildren and three great grandchildren.
