



Freida Buxbaum Lapp

August 5, 1920 - February 27, 2004

Freida Buxbaum Lapp, age 83, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, February 22, 2004 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, February 27, 2004 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Freida was born on August 5, 1920 in Killdeer, North Dakota, the daughter of Edward and Elizabeth (Diefel) Mittlestadt. She was raised and educated in Killdeer. Freida was united in marriage to Adam Buxbaum Jr. on July 16, 1938 in Sidney. Freida and Adam farmed in the Fairview area until they moved to Glendive in 1939. They operated a farm on the Buffalo Rapids Project until 1960 and during this time they also operated a dryland farm at Stipek and on the Murphy Table. Freida resided in the Forest Park area from 1960 until 2002. Adam preceded Freida in death in 1976. Freida was renowned as an excellent cook and she cooked for Norman LaMont at the Runway Café, Jack Wyse at the Montana Inn and for Curt Meeds at the Jordan Hotel. She also cooked at the Sacred Heart school cafeteria for a number of years. She was united in marriage to Frank Lapp on May 10, 1980 in Glendive. Freida enjoyed crocheting and she and Frank enjoyed gardening, dancing, and playing cards with the family. He preceded her in death in 1995. Freida was a member of the Women of the Moose and the V.F.W. Auxiliary. She was preceded in death by a sister, Olga and two brothers, Ernest and Walter. Freida is survived by three

daughters, Betty Barthel and her husband Don, Alyce Warrenburg and her husband Keith and Jane Colbrese and her husband Ron, all of Glendive; one son, Adam Leroy Buxbaum and his wife Rita of Glendive; three brothers, Richard Mittlestadt and his wife Helen and Alvin Mittelstaedt and his wife Edna, all of Glendive and Don Mittlestadt and his wife Leona of Missoula; one sister, Irene Reynolds and her husband Leo of Hillsboro, Oregon; 12 grandchildren, LaRae Semingson, Laurie Feist, Mike Barthel, Craig Barthel, Jon Barthel, Teresa Stephens, Steven Warrenburg, Victor Colbrese, Leslie Colbrese, Adam Bradley Buxbaum, Robert Buxbaum and Tyler Buxbaum, 24 great grandchildren, one great great grandchild and several nieces and nephews.
