Frieda (Bertsch) Maier, age 89, of Glendive passed away on Thursday, February 11, 2016 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. Frieda taught herself to sew on an old Singer treadle sewing machine and loved to take in sewing - made clothes from scratch, even wedding dresses. She did mending for people and embroidered dishtowels, which everyone asked for!

Frieda also took in ironing and cleaned houses for other people. In her garage, she conducted a business called, "Frieda's Resale Shop". She enjoyed tending to her flower beds and garden, going fishing, playing cards,

doing puzzles and later playing bingo at Extended Care during her stay there. She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Walter in 2008; daughter, Ann Lindvig in 2005; and her oldest sister, Mary Bush and brother, Harry Bertsch.

She is survived by her four children, Larry (Peggy) Maier, Anita (Clive) Wiles, Jan (Mick) McCleod and Brenda (Tomas) Delao; son-in-law, Steve (Wanda) Lindvig; thirteen grandchildren; thirty great-grandchildren; eight great, great-grandchildren; two sisters; Francis Priebe and Betty Hagen; one sister-in-law, Maggie Bertsch; and numerous nieces and nephews.
