



Gary Dean Reinhart

September 21, 1963 - November 2, 2023

Gary Dean Reinhart, age 60, of Glendive, Montana passed away on Thursday, November 2, 2023, at the Glendive Medical Center. A Life Tribute Service will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, November 13, 2023, at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Celebrant Heidi Carney officiating. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Gary was born to Dale and Margaret "Marge" (McGaughey) Reinhart in Glendive on September 21, 1963. He was raised and educated in Glendive, graduating with the DCHS Class of 1982. After high school he attended the North Dakota State School of Science in Wahpeton, North Dakota, receiving a Certificate of Machine Tooling in 1984, and then lived in both Billings and Cambridge, Minnesota working as a Machinist and CNC Operator. In 1986, Gary moved to Mesa, Arizona where he worked as a CNC Machinist / Operator for 15 years, producing both Aerospace and Commercial parts. In 2002 he attended a Residential Inspection Training and became registered as a Home Inspector in Arizona, at which time he opened his own business, Rimrock Inspection Services. In 2004, Gary decided to return to Glendive, and he brought his business with him, doing home inspections in Eastern Montana. Gary also worked at various other jobs since he returned, including Sidney Sugars, Mindt Machine, Elks Club, Truck Suppliers, Ptech Drilling Tubulars and the VFW. Due to health issues, he stopped working for a couple of years, until returning to the workforce at the end of 2021 to work as a Cook at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home. He worked there until his health once

again forced him to leave earlier this year, although he felt he was on the mend and in the last few months had been looking forward to returning to work.

Gary was a friendly person and seldom seen without a smile, he liked people and being around them. He enjoyed playing his guitars, fishing, guns and trap shooting, coin collecting, hot rod cars and collecting recipes he wanted to try. He liked doing things for others and would help people whenever he could. He was preceded in death by his parents. Gary is survived by his brother, David Reinhart of Williston, North Dakota; three nephews, Brandon (Jessica) Reinhart of Glendive, Bradley (Toree) Reinhart of Sidney, and Bryce Reinhart of Billings; three great-nephews, Braxton, Kamdyn and Layne of Glendive; one great-niece, Paislee of Sidney; aunts, uncles and numerous cousins. 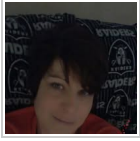
