



George "Lee" Leland Hostetler

March 7, 1934 - May 26, 2021

George (Lee) Hostetler, age 87, of Glendive, went home to be with our Lord on Wednesday, May 26 at 12:05 am at his home after a week in the hospital followed by a short time of hospice care.

He was born in the Bloomfield area where the family moved from place to place, settling for a time in South Valley, a cross-in-the-road northeast of Bloomfield where his dad operated a blacksmith shop. He went through several years of his education in the South Valley School ending his formal education with eight grades, but later completing his GED.

He worked for a number of farmers in the Bloomfield area for several years. During this time he met and married Verna M. Sturgis on June 2, 1954 and exactly one year later had the first of five boys.

They moved into Glendive when he began working for GTA elevator and soon found himself driving up and down the road hauling grain, feed and whatever else needed hauling. His trucking career spanned most of five decades and several million miles without a serious accident. Following his retirement from trucking he began driving activity bus for the high school where he was beloved by the kids he hauled around.

George loved the outdoors and especially spending time at Fort Peck Lake.

Early-on, family summer vacations were planned there with multiple trips each year for fishing, swimming, waterskiing and fellowship. The last trip that George made to the lake was August 2020.

George is survived by his wife Verna of Glendive; five sons Norman (Sue), Craig (Dea), Bryan (Joyce) of Glendive, Jody (Erin) of Charleston, SC and Jeff (Toni) of Bismarck, ND; two sisters Mildred Johnson of Terry, MT, Shirley Yoder of Wolford, ND; two brothers, Lyle Hostetler of Helena, MT, Don (MaryAnn) Hostetler of Bozeman, MT; 16 grandchildren, 28 great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.

He was predeceased by his father Edward, mother Violet Hostetler, his brother Bob and two grand-sons Thomas and Zach.

George will be sorely missed by all who knew him. Visitation will be Monday, May 31 from 5 – 8 pm. at Silha Funeral Home in Glendive.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday June 1 at 11:00 am at the Red Top Church east of Bloomfield with Pastor Darrell Nefzger officiating. Interment will follow at the Red Top Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

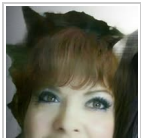

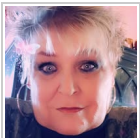
