



## George D. Huebert

August 30, 1914 - August 19, 2003

George D. Huebert, age 88, of Glendive and formerly of Lustre, Montana, passed away on Tuesday, August 12, 2003 in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, August 19, 2003 at the Evangelical Mennonite Brethren Church in Lustre with Pastor Neville Peterson officiating. Interment will be in the Bethel Lustre Mennonite Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. George was born on August 30, 1914 in Henderson, Nebraska, the son of Jacob F. and Sara (Dick) Huebert. He moved to the Lustre community with his parents in 1917. George was raised and educated in Lustre and he attended the Lustre Bible School. As a teenager, George accepted Christ as his personal Savior and was baptized in 1930, joining the Bethel Lustre Mennonite Church. He farmed and ranched with his father, and later started with his own herd of sheep. George entered the U.S. Army in 1942 and served in the Pacific Theatre of World War II. Following his discharge in 1945, George returned to the home place northwest of Wolf Point where he worked with his father. He later bought and rented portions of the farm until 1981 when he retired. George moved to Glendive in 1983 where he lived with his sister until the time of his death. George enjoyed working with animals. He immensely enjoyed his coffee hours and friends every day. When his health deteriorated to where he was confined to his home - his friends came to him, bringing him laughter and much happiness - thank you guys! His eyesight did not permit him to read much anymore, so he enjoyed watching sports on the television. George was

preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Sarah Quiring and Agnes Quiring and one brother, John Huebert. Survivors include his brothers, Jacob D. Huebert of Glasgow, Montana and Frank D. Huebert of Fairview, Oklahoma; three sisters, Lena Gray of Glasgow, Montana, Marie Goertzen and Anna Huebert, both of Glendive; numerous nieces and nephews.
