George Kent, age 89, of Glendive passed away on Sunday, June 24, 2007 under hospice care at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive . George was born on September 3, 1917 in Stipek, Montana, the youngest child born to Adolphus and Margaret (Frankenburg) Kent. George grew up on his parents homestead on Lower Seven Mile Creek. He attended the rural Lower Seven Mile School. As he grew up, George enjoyed hunting and fishing. While in Glendive, George had worked for Johnson-Udem Construction of Glendive - building the Glendive Community Hospital, which later became Glendive Medical Center and he continued to operate the family homestead. George remained on the family homestead until the late 1960's when he sold his interest in the farm to his brother and moved to the state of Washington. While living in Washington, George was married to Lee and they were later divorced but remained good friends. George lived and worked in Sequim, Washington as a carpenter, housepainter and handyman for a number of years before retiring and moving back to Glendive in the late 1980's. He enjoyed working

and taking care of his home in Sequim. In his retirement years, George enjoyed attending senior dances and family gatherings. He was preceded in death by his parents; sisters, Hazel Reinart, Maude Jimison, Evelyn Udem, Jesse Molenda and one brother, John, who died as an infant. He is survived by one brother, Willard Kent and his wife Ida Mae of Glendive; several nieces and nephews and a special friend, Muriel Willoughby, of Glendive.
