June 9, 1923 - February 15, 2003

George W. Scherger, age 79, of Glendive, passed from this earth to a more peaceful place on Sunday, February 9, 2003 surrounded by his family at his home in Glendive. George was one of the original organizers of Little League Baseball in Glendive. George had a great love of the outdoors and enjoyed gardening, hunting, fishing and golfing. He
