



Georgine Bronson

June 15, 1939 - April 17, 2003

Georgine Henrietta (Kniepkamp) Bronson, age 63, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, April 13, 2003 at her home in Glendive. Memorial services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, April 17, 2003 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor Ray Willis officiating. Private family interment will be in the Riverview Cemetery in Circle. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Georgine was born on June 15, 1939 in Circle, Montana, the daughter of Harry and Hilda (Albrigton) Kniepkamp. Hilda married Joe Kudrna and he adopted Georgine. Georgine was raised and educated in Circle, graduating with the Circle High School class of 1957. She then attended nursing school in Havre. Georgine was married to William E. Kamp on June 18, 1957 and to this marriage two sons, Dean and Gus were born. Bill preceded her in death on August 9, 1967. She married James "Red" Henry on February 8, 1969 in Glendive and to this union, a daughter, Suzette "Suzi" was born. Georgine and Red were later divorced. Georgine married Larry Bronson in West Yellowstone in 1986 and they resided in Casper, Wyoming. Georgine had worked at the Jordan Hotel, Wagon Wheel Bar and was the manager of the Last Gasp Saloon. She received her Certified Nurse Assistant degree and worked in Circle, Montana, at nursing homes in Nebraska and then returned to Glendive where she worked at Eastmont Human Services Center and the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. In October of 2002, Georgine had to quit work due to her health and fought a courageous battle with cancer until the time of her

death. She was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary and the Sons of Norway. Georgine enjoyed dancing and playing cards. Survivors include two sons, Dean Kamp of Glendive and Gus Kamp of Circle; one daughter, Suzette "Suzi" Wagner of Glendive; one brother, Stan Kniepkamp of Circle; two sisters, Clara Jane Way of California and Patsy Witte of Salmon, Idaho; 9 grandchildren.
