Beach, North Dakota: Gerald Curl, age 86, of Beach died peacefully on Tuesday, July 5, 2011 at the St. Alexius Medical Center in Bismarck, North Dakota after a four month valiant fight with lung cancer. Until his Freshman year Gerald attended school in Golva and then finished at Beach High School, graduating with the class of 1943. Gerald also attended school in Glendale, California for a short time. On December 23, 1945, he and Judith Roalsvig of Arnegard, North Dakota were married at the Wilmington Lutheran Church. They lived at the Curl farm in the "little" house, until 1953 when Gerald's parents moved to Beach. Gerald and Judy and the three oldest children then moved into the "big" house, where they were joined by three more children. Gerald served on the Lone Tree Township Board, the Council on Aging, Senior Citizens, the Golden Valley-Billings County Social Service Board for 39 years and worked on election boards. He was a Shriner and a member of the

Masonic Lodge in Beach and Belfield, North Dakota and in 1966 he was Worthy Grand Patron of the Order of Eastern Star, and served many years as Worthy Patron of Beach Chapter #70 OES. Gerald was a member of the First Lutheran Church and before that he was a member of the Beach United Community Church. He was always active in whatever organization he belonged to. He loved farming and repairing anything he could get his hands on. He also drove bus for the Golva Public School. Gerald is survived by his wife, Judith; sons, James (Joni) of Gainesville, Florida, Robert (Sheila) of Bismarck, North Dakota, Rick (Linda) of Golva, and daughter Karen Kremer of Tucson, Arizona; daughters-in-law, Sheryl of Sioux Falls, South Dakota and Annette of Lincoln, North Dakota. Grandchildren, Kim (Paul) Link, Kristi Mandsager, Jared Curl, Jacob and Samuel Stoveland, Teresa (Erik) Sweet, Lewis James Curl, Justin (Sarah) Schillo and Brian Schillo.
