



Gerald Otto Feldmann

June 2, 1944 - April 26, 2024

After fifty-nine years of married life, work and failing health, Gerald Otto Feldmann, age 79, of Beach, North Dakota was called home to Heaven from his pain on April 26, 2024. Visitation will be held from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Thursday, May 2, 2024 at Silha Funeral Home in Beach. A Funeral Service will be held at 10:00 AM on Friday, May 3, 2024 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Beach with Pastor Anthony Arhendt officiating. Gerald Otto Feldmann was given life by his Creator and born on June 2, 1944, the child of Leonhard F. and Hedwig M. (Hupke) Feldmann. He was reborn as the child of God in the waters of Holy Baptism on July 16, 1944. Gerald was confirmed in the Christian faith and was fed the life-giving body and blood of Jesus at St. Paul's Lutheran Church.

Gerald graduated from Beach High School in 1962 and attended St. John's College in Winfield, KS. On December 27, 1964 he was married to Barbara J. Holl in Derby, KS and returned to live and work, farming and joining the family construction business. In March of 1966, "Jerry" joined the USAF and served as an Electrical Repairman on the cargo MAC planes at Tinker AFB in Oklahoma during Vietnam. They headed home February 27, 1970, with his and Barbara's first child, Rhonda.

Gerald is survived by his wife, Barbara J. Feldmann of Beach; sons, Mark E. Feldmann (Kristin Payne) of St. Paul, MN and David C. (Christina) Feldmann

of Beach; twelve grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; two sisters; an aunt and numerous cousins.

Gerald is preceded in death by his parent, Leonhard and Hedwig; his beloved daughter, Rhonda Suzanne Feldmann Kosmerl and one grandchild.
