Gerald Jacob Job, of Wibaux, Montana went with Jesus on Tuesday, September 21, 2021. Visitation will be held 6:00 PM until 7:00 PM with a Vigil Service at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, September 28, 2021 at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, September 29, 2021 at St. Peter's Catholic Church with Father Jose officiating. Rite of Committal will take place at the Wibaux City Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux has been entrusted with the arrangements. Gerald was born on February 19, 1959 in Glendive, Montana to Norbert and Agnes (Olheiser) Job. He grew up on the family farm 1 mile south of Wibaux and lived most of his life in Wibaux. Gerry, as what family and friends called him, attended Wibaux Elementary School and Wibaux County High School during which Gerry was involved in basketball and football. He graduated from WCHS with the class of 1977.

Gerry worked in Fairview, Montana and after returning to Wibaux, he became involved with the Wibaux and Glendive High School's as a bus driver, substitute teacher, as well as coaching volleyball and then officiating at matches. Gerry was beginning to officiate for college matches. He was excited to move up to the next level as a volleyball official. Gerry was a jack of all trades but his career as a firefighter for the Montana DNRC in the Clearwater National Forest was his most cherished accomplishment. He loved going out to help every summer and would stay longer if needed. Gerry was very involved at volunteering with the Wibaux Fire Department and as an EMT on

the Ambulance Crew. In early years, he was active in the Knights of Columbus Council #8370, Assembly 1865, especially the free throw contest. He could also be found taking pictures at sports games or other events for the Wibaux Pioneer Gazette and working with his friend Frank Datta, putting out the paper each week.

Gerald is survived by brothers, Mark (Tammie) Job, Mike (Anita) Job, and Steve Job; sisters, Phyllis (Daryl) Wandler, Paula (Steve) Blohm, Norma Job and Carol Job; nephew, Anthony Blohm; niece, Jessica Blohm; three uncles, three aunts and numerous cousins.

Gerald was preceded in death by his parents; a brother, Gerald Mark and a sister, Francine.
