



Gerhard Saur

August 15, 1919 - April 16, 2005

Gerhard Saur, 85, of Monroe, Wash., formerly of Glendive, passed away on Thursday, April 7, 2005, at his daughter's home following a short illness. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Saturday, April 16, 2005 at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will be at Dawson Memorial Cemetery. Memorial services will be held at a later date at Morning Star Lutheran Church in Monroe, where he had been a member for the past six years. Mr. Saur was born August 15, 1919 in Vanstel, Mont. to William and Emilie(Mittelstaedt) Saur. He was raised and educated in Vanstel and in 1936 moved to Marsh. He was united in marriage to Mathilda³Tillie² Huft on June 29, 1941. He served in the U.S. Army as a Radio Operator in the European Theater, receiving five battle awards as well as a Purple Heart. Following his discharge, Mr. Saur worked for various farmers and had a mail route in Marsh and Cabin Creek for 11 years. In 1958, Mr. Saur began his 25-year career as caretaker of Dawson County Cemetery, retiring June 30, 1983. In May of 1999, he and his wife moved to Monroe, where they resided with their daughter and son-in-law. Mr. Saur enjoyed reminiscing, yard work, reading, and traveling by bus so he could see the countryside. He was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive and taught Sunday school for many years. Mr. Saur was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, two brothers and one sister. Survivors include his daughter Glenda (Edward) Skartved of Monroe; two sons, Michael of Cheyenne, Wyo. and Clayton (Benita) of Bismarck, N.D.; two brothers, William of Billings, and
