September 18, 1904 - March 4, 2008

Wibaux - Germaine Cora (Joubert) Bold Kramer, age 103, formerly of Glendive, Montana, passed away Saturday, March 1, 2008 in the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. A Vigil Service will held 7:00 p.m. Monday, March 3, 2008 in the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Chapel in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, March 4, 2008 in St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux with Father Denis Fournier officiating. Rite of Committal will follow in the Wibaux Cemetery. Visitation will be held 3:00 - 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. Monday, March 3 in the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Chapel in Wibaux. Germaine was born September 18, 1904, in Antigo, Wisconsin, to Noah and Emma (Young) Joubert. Her family moved to Eastern Montana when she was 8 years old and later to Fryburg, North Dakota, where she completed her elementary education. She graduated from Wibaux County High School and completed Teacher Certification in Miles City, Montana. Her contribution to education spanned more than 50 years. Her teaching career began at St. Phillip School, South of Wibaux, and ended in her privately owned kindergarten in Glendive. A resourceful individual, she started the first private kindergarten in Eastern Montana. Germaine married Peter Bold on August 5, 1924 in Belfield, North Dakota. They operated the Bold family homestead North of Wibaux, where they raised four children, William, Charmaine, Joyce and Dolores. Peter preceded her in death in 1985. She married Michael Kramer on April 10, 1988 in Glendive, Montana. He also preceded her in death. She was preceded in death by her parents; her son, William; her siblings Ezra (Mabel) Joubert, Ethel Joubert, Ozannah (William) Howard, Leonard (Eunice) Joubert, Earl (Esther) Joubert, and Marvel (Alphonse) Guelff; and grandson, James Bold.
