Gertrude Emma Kriedemann, age 101, of Minot, North Dakota, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Monday, November 16, 2009 at ManorCare Health Services in Minot. She graduated from Granville High School with the class of 1928 and went on to attend colleges in Minot and Dickinson, North Dakota, and Lincoln, Nebraska. On May 30, 1937, Gertrude married William J. Kriedemann in Drake, North Dakota. In 1959, she taught school for eight years in Beulah, North Dakota, while William remained in Beach. In 1967, she returned to Beach and taught at the Seventh-Day Adventist Church. She also worked for many years in the Golden Valley County Auditor's office. Gertrude retired in 1989. She belonged to the Hospital Auxiliary, Right To Life, and the Senior Citizens' Center. She thoroughly enjoyed reading and crafts. Gertrude loved to read the Bible and was quite active in Bible studies. Gertrude was

preceded in death by her parents, her husband, William and her half-brother, John Davis. Gertrude is survived by her half-brother, Walter Davis of Arizona; her half-sisters, Nellie Pfau of Upham, North Dakota, Agnes Beeter of Minot, North Dakota, and Lanney Dwello of Minneapolis, Minnesota; and numerous nieces and nephews.
