December 18, 1923 - November 27, 2021

Gladys L. Krogstad, age 97, of Glendive, Montana passed away on Saturday, November 27, 2021 at the Glendive Medical Center.

She was born in Ada, Minnesota to Fred and Ella (Eckhoff) Fetting on December 18, 1923. Mom grew up on a farm and attended country schools through the eighth grade then started high school in town, not something everyone in those days had the chance to do. Since getting from the farm to town in the winter could be an adventure, if you made it at all, she stayed with friends in town during those months so her schooling would not be interrupted by a Minnesota blizzard that could closely resemble those that occur in the Arctic. She graduated from Ada High School in 1941 then met and on November 6, 1947 married Allen Krogstad in Glendive Montana where they lived all their married life.

Mom was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Chancel Guild, P.E.O., Hospital Auxiliary, V.F.W. Auxiliary, plus any social group that involved playing bridge. Mom loved to play bridge and did so whenever someone needed her to complete a foursome and she could work it into her schedule. She spent many hours telling us about some of her better bridge hands even though we didn't have a clue what any of it meant but since she was so excited in the telling we listened as if we knew what she was talking about.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, Allen, in 1991, two brothers Earl and Alvin, six brothers-in-law, eight sisters-in-law, and many friends.

She is survived by her daughter Pastor Sondra Krogstad of Bismarck, ND; son Steve (Mona) Krogstad of Billings, MT, granddaughters Rachel (Alan) Wages, Kaleb, Paizlee and Anna of Montgomery, AL, and Alyson (Greg) McElwain, Emily, of Boise, ID; a brother, Don Eckhoff of Park Rapids, MN and a sister-in-law, Harriet Kidder of St. Paul, MN and numerous nieces and nephews; Henry and Darla Mischel, their daughters Calsey, Ashley and Janell, who were like family to mom and loved her as their own.

Her family would like to thank the wonderful caregivers at the Heritage Assisted Living in Glendive. They treated mom like family all the years that she lived there and she could not have received better care anywhere, they are the best.

Interment at the Dawson County Cemetery with a graveside service for immediate family is pending. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.
