Buchholz Pfeifle, age 57, of Glendive, Montana, formerly of Williston, North Dakota, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Tuesday, February 20, 2007 at the Glendive Medical Center after a long hard battle with diabetes and then cancer. Funeral service will be held at 11:00 A.M. (Central time), Monday, February 26, 2007 at the English Lutheran Church in Tuttle, North Dakota with Pastor Val Kinlan officiating. Interment will be in the Zion Langedahl Cemetery in Tuttle. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Gladys was born on December 20, 1949, in Bismarck, North Dakota, the youngest of three children born to Herman and Christina (Schock) Buchholz. She was raised on the family farm near Tuttle, North Dakota and graduated from high school there. She later attended Devils Lake School of Nursing and graduated in 1972. Following her graduation she worked at several hospitals. In 1975, Gladys married Sherman Pfeifle and they made their home in Baker, Montana for a number of years where Gladys worked as a dispatcher for the Police Department. They later moved to Noonan, North Dakota where Gladys became the Director of Nursing. Several years later the worsening of her life long plague with Type I Brittle Sugar Diabetes forced her to retire from nursing due to her failing eyesight. Her condition worsened through the years and so did her kidneys. In 1986 she underwent a kidney transplant with the kidney donated by her only sister - she never gave up. Gladys was a very kind, soft spoken person with so much love to give. She touched everyone she came in contact with her

beautiful and magnetic smile. She was loved by many. She loved nursing and helping others. She also enjoyed baking, ceramics and dancing. She especially loved her nieces, nephews, grand nieces and grand nephews. Gladys is preceded in death by her parents and her husband. Survivors include her brother, Orvin Buchholz and his wife Mary B. of Tuttle, North Dakota; her sister, Aggie Stecher and her husband Richard of Glendive; her special friend, Sid Kennedy of Williston, North Dakota; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and many friends.
