Gladys Pearl Russell, 94, died on September 25, 2008 at the Glendive Extended Care in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at the United Methodist Church in Glendive on Monday, September 29, 2008 at 10:00 A.M. with Pastor T.C. Chatman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with the arrangements. Pearl was born on December 3, 1913 in Cumberland, Iowa the daughter of Samuel and Grace (Shepherd) Lehman. She moved, with her family, to Dawson County, Montana in 1915 to the Lindsay area. Pearl received her early education in rural Dawson county at the Pierce School, south of Lindsay, Montana in the Union area. She attended Dawson County High School in Glendive, graduating with the class of 1933. She attended a commercial course at Billings Business College in Billings, Montana. On July 15, 1942, Pearl married Gordon Russell in Glendive, where they raised their family and resided in the same home since 1945. She loved flower gardening, growing and selling vegetables, canning, traveling with Gordon and walking. Pearl had been employed with the ASCS office in Glendive for over thirty years as a program assistant. She was an active member of the Glendive United Methodist Church, and was involved in the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary and Women of the Moose, serving as President of the Degree of Honor. Pearl was preceded in death by her husband, Gordon, in August of 1998; a daughter, Hazel Raden, in 1999; two grandsons, Mark Raden and Scott Brager; four sisters, Marjorie Globstad, Frances Hansen, Mary Suepke

and Rose Walsh; two brothers, Bert and John Lehman. Survivors include one son, Clifford Russell and his wife Sharon of Glendive; one daughter, MaryAnn Brager and her husband Harlan of Kenmore, Washington; one sister, Bernice Bren; a sister-in-law, Renee Lehman of Lignite, North Dakota, 7 grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
