



Glen Williamson

May 16, 1921 - February 20, 2004

Glen Morris Williamson, age 82, of Glendive, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday, February 13, 2004 at the Deaconess Billings Clinic in Billings, Montana. Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m., Friday, February 20, 2004 at the Glendive Alliance Church with his son Reverend D. Paul Williamson and Pastor Joel Arndt officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Glen, the third child of a family of four, was born on May 16, 1921 on the family farm near Ava, Illinois, the son of Don and Murtie (Wirtz) Williamson. On June 12, 1942, he entered the U.S. Army and served overseas, during World War II. He was honorably discharged from the military with the rank of Sergeant on January 9, 1946. He and Irma Alice Whisler were married June 6, 1947 in Nashville, Illinois. Together they ran the farm until he felt called by God to become a Minister. The spring of 1950 found them with their firstborn son Roger, heading to Chicago to enroll in Moody Bible Institute. While attending Bible School and earning a living to support his family, which grew with two more babies being born, Paul and Ed, while in Chicago, he worked at different jobs, graduating with the Class of 1955. Now he was ready to do what he was called to do. Over the years he pastored churches in Ohio, California, Kansas, Illinois, Michigan, Montana and Oklahoma. His love for the Lord and people allowed him many opportunities to share his faith through Bible Studies, Vacation Bible Schools, Youth Groups and summer Bible Camps. Glen is preceded in death by his wife, Irma, by

both his parents, Don and Murtie Williamson, one brother, Galan, and one son, Roger Dean Williamson. Glen is survived by his children; two sons, Reverend D. Paul Williamson and his wife Helen of Honesdale, Pennsylvania and Ed Williamson and his wife Sharon of Glendive; his daughter, Sharon Grove of Glendive; two sisters, Helen Stout of Wyoming, and Mildred Vaughn, of Illinois; ten grandchildren and seven great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
