August 9, 1921 - July 20, 2005

Gordon Johnson, age 83, of Glendive, passed away on Saturday, July 16, 2005 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Wednesday, July 20, 2005 in the Chapel of the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive with Pastor Ray Willis officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Gordon was born on August 9, 1921 in Northwood, North Dakota, the son of George and Olive (Halvorson) Johnson. He was raised and educated in Powers Lake, North Dakota. Gordon entered the U.S. Army in 1942, serving in the European Theatre of World War II and in the Korean War. He retired from the military in 1967. Shortly after his retirement from the military, he had a stroke. He moved to Glendive in 1971 to be with his brother. In 1981, he went to the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care and became the first resident of the Eastern Montana Veterans Home when it opened in 1995. Gordon was known for his sense of humor. Gordon was a member of the V.F.W., American Legion and the Disabled American Veterans. He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother. Survivors include his brother, Paul "Shorty" Johnson of Glendive; his sister, Gertrude "Gert" Knutson of Deer Lodge, Montana; numerous nieces and nephews.
