July 16, 1915 - November 14, 2003

Gudrun "Goodie" Udem, age 88, of Glendive, died on Saturday, November 8, 2003 at the Sidney Health Center in Sidney, Montana. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Friday, November 14, 2003 at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Goodie was born on July 16, 1915 in Glendive, Montana the daughter of Norwegian immigrants Eivind L. and Gurina (Stangeland) Kalberg. She attended rural Dawson County schools and Washington School in Glendive. Goodie graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1933. She attended Western College in Dillon from 1933 to 1936. Goodie taught at schools in rural Dawson County and at Washington School. She married Sigurd Udem August 8, 1943 in Miles City, Montana. They ranched in Prairie County until 1954 when they purchased a farm in the Pleasantview community. Sigurd preceded Goodie in death in 1977. Goodie was a true woman of Montana who always had time for a sick animal or youth in need. Goodie was a member of the Order of Eastern Star and served as Worthy Matron of Yellowstone Chapter #5 and Terry Chapter #74. She also held several positions of honor in the state chapter and served on many committees. Goodie was a Dawson County High School Board Member for 10 years. Goodie was preceded in death by her parents; one brother and one sister. Survivors include one brother, Einer Kalberg of Buhl, Idaho; her daughter, Margo Hellickson of Glendive; her son, Sam Udem of

Glendive; a niece she raised, Diane Hoffman-Hyde of Billings, Montana; three grandchildren, Chris Udem and his wife Sarah and their daughter Keely, Sven Udem and Sigurd Hellickson, all of Glendive and numerous nieces.
