



## Harold Crockett

April 12, 1918 - July 16, 2004

Harold Crockett, age 86, of Richey, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, July 14, 2004 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Friday, July 16, 2004 at the American Lutheran Church in Richey with Pastor David Aaseng officiating. Interment with military honors will be in the Richey Cemetery in Richey. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Harold was born on April 12, 1918 on the family homestead in Bloomfield, Montana, the son of James Berton and Carrie (Lease) Crockett. He attended Bloomfield schools. When Harold was 18 years old, his father passed away and he took over the family farm in Bloomfield. He volunteered for the U.S. Army in 1942 and served in France, Belgium, and Germany. He was honorably discharged in 1945. Following his discharge from the military, Harold returned to farming in the Bloomfield and Richey areas. He married LaVerna Taasaas in Glendive and together they raised four sons and one daughter. Harold was a member of the V.F.W. Post #7887, and the American Legion for over 50 years. He was a member of the Moose Lodge. Harold was a very patriotic man who took great pride in his country. He loved to work and when the work was done, the memories were made trying to catch "the big one". Harold loved to take the kids fishing where many afternoons were spent at the "favorite fishin' hole". Whether the big one was caught or not, the best times were had by all. Harold's pride and joy were his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. He especially enjoyed the many family get-togethers. Harold

enjoyed the "simple life".
