



## Harold Schmitz

November 14, 1940 - March 18, 2008

Harold "Harry" Ernest Schmitz, age 67, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Friday, March 14, 2008, at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dickinson, North Dakota. A Vigil will be held at 7:00 P.M., Monday, March 17, 2008, at the Golden Valley Manor Chapel in Beach. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, March 18, 2008, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva, North Dakota, with Father David Richter officiating. Rite of Committal will follow in St. Mary's Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Harry was born on November 14, 1940, in Beach, North Dakota, the son of Ernest and Alberta (Barthel) Schmitz. Harry was raised on a farm near Golva, North Dakota. He graduated from Golva High School and then attended Dickinson State College in Dickinson, North Dakota, and the State School of Science in Wahpeton, North Dakota, where he took up electronics. Harry farmed in the Golva area for several years with his father Ernie and on his own. He also worked for Bogner Appliance and Sandy Music in Dickinson and for the United States Postal Service in Golva. For the past few years, Harry had been a resident at the Golden Valley Manor in Beach. Many people in the Golva and Beach area knew Harry for his generosity and for the work he did with satellite television and radio communications systems. Harry was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva and a member of St. Joseph's Council of the Knights of Columbus in Golva. Harry was preceded in death by his parents, Ernie and Alberta Schmitz; two sisters, Joan Clouse and Judy Lavin; and two infant brothers,

Daniel and James. Harry is survived by his brother, Dave Schmitz and his wife Linda of Bismarck, North Dakota; his sister, Jean Hill and her husband Ron of Bismarck, North Dakota; six nephews and four nieces.
