



## Harold Temple

November 26, 1935 - April 26, 2006

Harold Warren Temple, age 70, of Intake, Montana, passed away on Thursday, April 20, 2006 at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. A Memory Service will be held 7:00 P.M. Tuesday, April 25, 2006 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M. Wednesday, April 26, 2006 at the Evangelical Church of North America in Glendive, Montana, with Pastor Allen Solheim officiating. Interment will be in the Intake Cemetery near Intake. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Harold was born on November 26, 1935 in Glendive, Montana, the son of Carl and Agnes (Jonas) Temple. Harold was raised and educated in Glendive graduating from Dawson County High School in 1953. He attended Montana State University in Bozeman. Harold married Dorothy Lucht on June 9, 1956 in Saco, Montana. They were later divorced. Harold married Luella "Lou" Brunsvold on May 25, 1979 in Sidney, Montana. Harold worked at Gate City Dairy from 1955 until the mid 1980's. Harold did many different jobs at the dairy and knew all aspects of the business. In 1968, Harold started a custom haying operation and continued that until he sold the equipment in the late 1970's. He also worked as a ditch rider for the Lower Yellowstone Irrigation Project for two years. Harold and Lou leased the Anne Fletcher Ranch in 1981. He worked very hard to make it the River Bend Red Angus Ranch, a member of the American Red Angus Association, and Harold operated it until the time of his death. In 1993, Harold was Dawson County Conservation Farmer of the Year. Harold was a member of the Glendive Elks

Lodge #1324. He enjoyed farm work, hunting and fishing. He always had a special place in his heart for his grandchildren and many friends, including his dogs. He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Charles, Ray and Chet; and his special cousin, Anne Fletcher. Harold is survived by his wife, Lou of Intake; four sons, Greg and his wife Vicki, Jim and his wife Joan, Tom and his wife Amy all of Glendive, and Dan of Phoenix, Arizona; three step children, Lance Brunsvold and his wife Mary Jo of Bangkok, Thailand, Kevin Brunsvold and his wife Kathy of Billings, Montana and Jill VandeBossche and her husband Dick of Sidney; a sister, Irene Bolin of West Lafayette, Indiana; 17 grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
