Following their marriage, Harriet managed her parents beauty salon in Marshfield, Wisconsin while John attended Chiropractic College in Indiana. Upon his graduation from college, the family moved to Glendive where she had resided since. Harriet owned and operated a beauty shop in Glendive where she had provided hairdresser services for over 65 years. Harriet's hobbies included swimming, playing bridge, hunting & fishing, knitting and singing for various events. She

was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, in September 1960; her son, Alan in October, 2006 and her sister.
