GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Harry Haas, age 88, passed away on Saturday, July 31, 2010 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home. He especially loved spending time with his family and cherished the times spent with his grandchildren. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1125 and the American Legion Club. He was preceded in death by his parents; his two wives; his sisters, Anna Peterson and Genevieve Hoff; brothers, Alvin, Adolf and Henry; an infant sister, Ida; his

son Rod and an infant grandson Herman Harry.
