



## Harvey Lyle Wolski

March 1, 1920 - April 29, 2025

Harvey Lyle Wolski, age 105 of Beach, North Dakota passed away on Tuesday, April 29th, 2025 with family by his side at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dickinson, North Dakota. Visitation will be held from 3:00 PM until 5:00 PM and from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Thursday, May 8, 2025 at the Silha Funeral Home in Beach. Graveside services with military honors will be at 11:00 AM on Friday, May 9, 2025 in the Dickinson Cemetery in Dickinson. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements. Harvey was born in Valley City, ND on March 1, 1920 to Herman and Louise (Barstad) Wolski. He attended a rural country school while growing up and helping on the family farm near Sanborn, ND until 1939. He then started working at a Chicken hatchery in Dickinson, ND. Later he moved back to Valley City and worked in a Texaco service station, his last job was as a mechanic at a Dodge dealership.

On January 22, 1942 Harvey married the love of his life Ariel Viola Hayden in Wibaux, Montana. They started their life together in Slope County, North Dakota where Ariel was teaching. She then followed Harvey around the country after he enlisted in the army while he attended basic training in multiple states. Harvey was then assigned to the Army's 3463rd Ordnance Medium Maintenance Company working on Jeeps and trucks. The Queen Elizabeth took him across the Atlantic, landing first in Scotland, then London, England. He finally made it to France then to Germany where he was assigned to General Patton's Army. After his military commitment was fulfilled

Harvey and Ariel settled in Beach, ND in 1946, there they had two children Sandra and Lyle. Rented out cabins and worked on their farm north of Beach. Harvey and Ariel had 75 wonderful years together.

Harvey loved farming, found peace and joy in working the land, raising and harvesting the crops was his passion, he continued working the farm until he was 101 years old. Yet Harvey and Ariel also enjoyed traveling which they did quite extensively visiting 49 states. Some of those travels were for army reunions, and family vacations some with their son, daughter-in-law and grandchildren: Samantha, Matthew, Nathaniel, and Jonathan which they loved so very much.

Harvey is preceded in death by his beloved wife Ariel; his daughter Sandra Brown; and his parents, Herman and Louise Wolski; his brother Arnold Wolski; his sister Olive Aman.

Harvey is survived by his son Lyle (Patti) Wolski of Mandan; four grandchildren, Samantha (Josh) sons Nolan and Trowa Dolajak of Mandan, Matthew (Miranda) daughters McKenzie and McKayla Wolski of Sidney, Mt, Nathaniel (Cheyenne) daughters Whillow, Whittlyn, and Whikkinley Wolski of Washburn, and Jonathan Wolski of ColeHarbor.
