January 11, 1912 - June 10, 2008

Hazel Peters, age 96, of Wibaux, Montana, passed away Thursday, June 5, 2008 in Wibaux. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, June 10, 2008 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive, Montana with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Hazel "Johnny" Peters was born on January 11, 1912 to Carl Victor Johnson and Anna Louise Johnson at Big Springs, Union County, South Dakota. She went to county school at Big Springs until the 8th grade and graduated as Valedictorian from high school at Alcester, South Dakota. She trained as a nurse at Madison Community Hospital until 1936, when she moved to Seattle, Washington. In Seattle she worked at Furland Sanitarium and was transferred in 1938 to the Seward, Alaska Hospital. She was married to Dr. Ray G. Banister in 1939 in Sioux City, Iowa and then moved to Seward and began a family, raising four children: Linda, Ray, Jr., Bruce, and BY. They lived in Seward until his untimely death in an airplane crash on December 26th, 1946. After losing Daddy B., the family moved to Spokane, Washington and stayed there until she married Arthur Peters of Wibaux, MT, where they lived until their deaths. We remember a faithful and godly mother and grandmother that adored poetry and music, that survived turmoil of the Great Depression and the deaths of two husbands, and that put her children and grandchildren first in her heart. She has been preceded in death by her parents, Carl and Anna Johnson; her siblings, Clarence Johnson, Claire

Jarvis, Kenneth Johnson, Edith Montagne; her son, Byron Banister; her grandson, Quinten Banister; her husband, Dr. Ray Banister; and her husband, Arthur Peters.
