



Hazel Cecilia Rogers

January 28, 1919 - December 27, 2014

Hazel Cecelia Rogers, age 95, formerly of Glendive, Montana, passed away in Billings, Montana on Saturday, December 27, 2014 at her home. Visitation will be held from 10:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Friday, January 2, 2015 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. A Funeral Service will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, January 3, 2015 at the Zion Lutheran Church with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Interment will follow in Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Hazel was born on January 28, 1919, in Wibaux County, Montana, a daughter of John William and Stella (Conner) Kegley. She spent her early childhood on a ranch north of Wibaux in the Blue Montana Country, where she attended country schools until the eighth grade. Hazel and her family moved into Wibaux where she continued her high school years at the Wibaux County High School graduating with the class of 1936. Following graduation, Hazel moved to Glendive working for Carey's Bakery and the Jordan Hotel until 1939 when she was united in marriage with Harvey Rogers. Together as a couple they lived in Terry, Montana from 1939 until 1946, where Harvey farmed and worked construction. Hazel and Harvey moved back to Glendive where Harvey was employed by Sterhan Construction.

Hazel and Harvey had two sons, Gary and Alan. Hazel stayed at home with the boys keeping up with their school and other activities. In 1958, she started working as a sales clerk for Anderson's Department Store where she stayed

for twenty-five and a half years. Following her retirement from there she kept busy keeping in touch with her family, enjoyed sewing, crocheting, and visiting with her friends during coffee time. She was an avid church member who helped with church activities. She and Harvey enjoyed many years of retirement with some traveling and visiting their family.

Hazel was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Harvey; her twin brother; three other brothers and three sisters.

Survivors include her sons, Gary (Janet) Rogers of Sandpoint, Idaho and Alan (Cherry) Rogers of Fort Mill, South Carolina; six grandchildren, Karl Rogers of Seattle, Washington, Ty (Stefani) Rogers of Willmington, North Carolina, Jason (Diedre) Rogers of Greensboro, North Carolina, Lerria (Tony) Schuh of Spokane, Washington, Dana (Andrew) Harper of Charlotte, North Carolina and Pamela (Brian) Elwood of San Jose, California; nine great-grandchildren; two brothers; two sisters and numerous nieces and nephews.
