Wibaux, Montana: Our dear mother and grandmother Helen Louise Mullet, age 95, passed away peacefully into the presence of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Sunday, April 24, 2011 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. In 1945 they bought a government farm on the Buffalo Rapids Irrigation Project, sold the farm in 1954 and moved to Glendive. Helen was head baker at the Jefferson School for many years and the children always looked forward to the cinnamon rolls. Helen and Bert were active as charter members of the Evangelical Church of North America in Glendive. She sang regularly in the Women's Choral group organized by their church until the age of 90 years old. Helen had a strong belief in the Lord and was always an encouragement to all. She possessed a

great love for her family. Helen enjoyed crocheting and playing Scrabble. She loved gardening and raised beautiful flowers and was a member of the Glendive Garden Club. Helen loved to bake rolls, cookies and angel food cakes for all occasions. She will be remembered for her cheerful spirit, kindness and hospitality. Helen was preceded in death by her husband Bert (1991); son Marlin (1959); parents; brothers Robert and Herbert; and sister Evelyn.
