Herbert “Herb” James Brown, age 91 of Richey, MT passed away on Monday, April 26, 2021 at the McCone County Health Center in Circle, MT. Herb enjoyed trapping and gardening; in the offseason he enjoyed reading about trapping and planning his garden for the next year. He loved spending time with his family and grandchildren and great grandchildren, and of course
