



Herbert Allen Sharbono

March 30, 1937 - August 22, 2021

Herbert "Herb" Allen Sharbono, age 84, of Glendive, Montana, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Sunday, August 22, 2021, at the Glendive Medical Center. Memorial services will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Friday, August 27, 2021, at the Glendive Alliance Church with Pastor Phil Elmer officiating. Interment with military honors will follow in the Dawson County Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Herb was born on March 30, 1937 in Sidney, Montana, a son of Sylvester and Carrie (Holler) Sharbono. He was raised on the family farm between Lambert and Savage. He attended the Sharbono School for most of his early education before finishing his schooling in Glendive. Herb decided school wasn't for him and set out to start working as a crane operator during the construction of a bridge in Glendive.

Herb met and was later united in marriage to Joanne Hampton on August 18, 1956, at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive and to this union five sons were born. A few years after their marriage Herb was drafted into the United States Army on March 10, 1959, during the Vietnam War. He received his Honorable Discharge on January 31, 1963. Following his discharge from service, Herb, Joanne, and their growing family returned to Glendive where Herb worked a couple different jobs before beginning his career with MDU. He worked at MDU for thirty-one years, starting out as a meter reader and working his way up to the Shop Foreman.

Sadly, on April 13, 1992, Joanne passed away after a courageous battle with

cancer. Herb later met Janet Skillestad and the two were married on July 29, 1997, in Glendive and with this union Herb welcomed five step-daughters into his family. Janet passed away on February 24, 2011.

In his earlier years, Herb enjoyed taking his sons out hunting, fishing, and agate hunting. During his retirement years, he could often be found tinkering on old vehicles and equipment. He loved old cars and restoring them. Herb also enjoyed helping his sons on their farms as much as he could. Later in life Herb could often be found volunteering at the Attic. Being the only man who volunteered, he and his family affectionately called the other women there "his ladies."

Above all was Herb's love of Jesus. He had a strong faith in the Lord, and he had looked forward to the day when he could meet Him in Heaven.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Sylvester and Carrie; his first wife Joanne; second wife, Janet; an infant son; four brothers, Donald, Sylvester, Carroll, and Loren; and four sisters, Dessie Mitchell, Faye Beyer, Christina Stanford and Louella Fischer.

Herb is survived by his sons, Bruce (Sue) Sharbono of Laurel, Montana, Joe (Kathy) Sharbono of Glendive, Mark (Deanna) Sharbono of Aurora, Colorado, and Daniel (Sally) Sharbono of Glendive; five step-daughters, Dona (Dave) Engle of Glendive, Shelley Jonas of Glendive, Lynn (Gary) Ingraham of Glendive, LaRae (Dave) Letzelter of Canyon, Texas, and Carol (Mike) Wolff of Lindsay, Montana; twenty-three grandchildren; twenty-four great-grandchildren; one brother, Delbert (Marcella) Sharbono of Clancy, Montana; one sister-in-law, Sheryl Sharbono of Sidney, Montana; and numerous nieces and nephews.
