



## Herman Brungard

January 11, 1915 - April 11, 2006

Herman C. Brungard, age 91, of Wibaux, Montana, died Thursday, April 6, 2006 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. Funeral Services will be held at 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, April 11, 2006 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Wibaux with Rev. Paul Peterson officiating. Interment with Military Honors will follow at the Wibaux Cemetery. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach is entrusted with arrangements. Herman was born January 11, 1915 in Wibaux a son of George C and Anna M. (Luccasen) Brungard. He was raised on a farm south of Wibaux in the Edgehill, Montana area. He was educated in Wibaux County schools graduating from Wibaux County High School with the class of 1932. Following his graduation from high school, Herman joined the United States Navy and served on the U.S.S. West Virginia. He was discharged in 1935 to return to Wibaux to work on the family farm after his fathers death. In 1941 he purchased his own farm where he worked until 1948 when he rented it out. Herman was married to Marjorie Nelson on September 5, 1949 in Wibaux, she preceded him in death in 1981. After renting out his farm Herman bought an interest in the City Service Garage where he worked until 1961. In 1961 Herman moved to Denver, Colorado where he worked as a parts manager in a automobile dealership until retiring in 1978. He moved back to his farm in 1978 where he lived until his marriage to Elizabeth Morgen on December 1, 1984 when he moved to their present home in Wibaux. Herman was a

member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Wibaux and the Masonic Lodge in Glendive, Montana. His hobbies included photography, woodworking, genealogy, traveling and music. He enjoyed working at the Wibaux Historical Museum for many years. Herman was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Stella Brungard; three brothers, Conrad, Calvin and Oscar Brungard. Herman is survived by his wife Elizabeth of Wibaux; three daughters, Alice Padgham and her husband Robert of Nanaimo, British Columbia, Canada, Barbara Maus and her husband David of Wibaux and Susan Finneman and her husband Joe of Beach, North Dakota; three Step daughters, Jennifer Kelly and her husband Gary of Fair Oaks, California, Phyllis Goldsmith and her husband Jerry of Covington, Georgia and Barbara Baker and her husband Darrel of Kalispell, Montana; two step sons, Larry Morgen of Wibaux, Montana and Joseph Morgen and his wife Sara of Amarillo, Texas; twenty grandchildren and twelve great grandchildren.
