Hilda Metcalf, age 91, of Glendive, Montana, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Tuesday, October 30, 2007, at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. Hilda was a member of Webb's Willing Workers in Trotters for many years. She belonged to the Beach Evangelical Church and was a member of the Ladies Aide. Hilda enjoyed music, baking, sewing, and quilting. She loved her family, especially the babies. Hilda was preceded in death by her parents; her

husband, Lloyd; one daughter; two grandchildren; four brothers; and two sisters.
